School divisions participating in the National School Lunch Program get cash subsidies and donated commodities from the U.S. Department of Agriculture for each meal they served. The lunches mush meet Federal requirements, and they must offer free or reduced-price lunches to eligible children. This state reimbursement program is required by the federal National Nutrition School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, and the After School Snack Program.

State funds are required to meet maintenance of effort and match requirements for the federal funds received for the school lunch programs. The rate of reimbursement is determined by the number of reimbursable lunches served during the previous year.
