

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

RE: Bedford County Public Schools, Liberty High School Hydronic Piping Loop Replacement, Bedford County, VA

Sealed bids on the referenced project will be received at the Bedford County Public School office located at 310 South Bridge Street, Bedford, VA, 24523 until **2:00 p.m.**, local prevailing time, **Tuesday, February 14, 2017** and then immediately following opened publicly and read aloud.

Bids may be withdrawn in accordance with the Code of Virginia Section 2.2-4330(a) Procedure (1).

The Liberty High School Hydronic Piping Loop Replacement project generally consists of installing new underground chilled and hot water piping systems that serve Buildings A, B, C, D, E, F, G, J and J1. Building K is not included in this project. The piping loop originates in Building D, which is the Boiler/Chiller Plant. The project includes selective demolition of existing underground chilled and hot water piping systems. New work includes installation of new pre-insulated piping for selective underground chilled and hot water piping systems. The new work will also entail the installation of underground piping anchors, expansion elbows, and expansion loops as part of the newly installed pre-insulated piping system.

The Contract will be awarded on a lump sum base bid.
