This state reimbursement program is required by the federal National Nutrition School Lunch Program, the School Breakfast Program, and the After School Snack Program.

State funds are required to meet maintenance of effort and match requirements for the federal funds received for the school lunch programs. The rate of reimbursement is determined by the number of reimbursable lunches served during the previous year.

SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAM (INCENTIVE)

Local school food authorities administer the School Breakfast Program at the local level. Participating schools must serve breakfasts that meet federal nutrition standards, and must provide free and reduced-price breakfasts to eligible children. This funding provides an incentive to increase student participation in the school breakfast program and to leverage increased federal funding resulting form higher participation.

This state reimbursement program provides up to \$0.20 per meal reimbursement to school divisions that increase the number of breakfasts served to students. The reimbursement is based on breakfast meals served in the prior year in excess of a baseline established by the department.
